There has been a lot of cautious anticipation building around the possible resumption of Penn Ohio events as it seems like we might be close to turning the corner on this pandemic. It helps that many of our members have been successfully vaccinated. So here is what has happened and what is planned.

Over the pass few months, I have talked with the presidents of the Penn Ohio chapters that were assigned to host events. These conversations started in January when things were still very uncertain. The first event to deal with was the Spring Banquet to be hosted by Copus Hill Chapter. After conversations with president Tom Franzen, we thought it would be a good idea to put out feelers to see what kind of attendance we could anticipate given the current state of affairs but with an eye on a hopeful Spring. The poll was conducted of the clubs that historically have the largest numbers of attendees at events and we found that we could expect 50-60 attendees. In recent years, this event has resulted in 110-120 attendees. So, we decided to pull the plug on the Spring Banquet and look to start up things with the next scheduled event, the July meet to be hosted by Erie Chapter. Talking to president Jerry Balczon, I found that they were all set to go with the venue reserved and we agreed that we would proceed with planning for the event unless the wheels came of in Pennsylvania and the authorities saw fit to restrict such gatherings. That took care of July. Ridge Runners Chapter was scheduled to host August meet. Darlynn Fink contacted me to see they could possibly move their event to September 12. NEO Chapter president, Jeff Thirion had informed me that NEO was not going to host an event this year, so September was open. I told Darlynn Fink to plan on September 122. That leaves August open. I know, it's NOT the 3rd Sunday, and YES, I know the board didn't approve the change. Call it an executive decision. (Feel free to replace the executive). October Fall Banquet will go on as planned with Cranksters Chapter as hosts.

So, the July Erie meet will kick off our season. Please try to attend. Presque Isle State Park is a great venue and fun trip in your "A".






TRI COUNTY CORRESPONDENT: DIANA STEWART
